<u>Motion 7:</u> The Arts Committee moves to approve funding not to exceed **\$1,600.00** from line item **2.06** (**Public Art**) for Out of Sight's additional funding for Wicker Park Fest's Arts Area to take place July 26-28th. (19-0612)

Discussion: DG explained the current RFP process. This additional funding was requested after the proposal was sent in. Multiple Commissioners agreed that artists needed to fit within the constraints of the \$5,000 initially outlined in the RFP and adjust their budgets accordingly. JH mentioned that additional funding to this organization specifically could be seen as showing favoritism to a current committee member, as no other applicants for this initiative sit on Arts Committee.

DG in favor, MH and JH opposed, no abstentions. Motion <u>not</u> approved.

c. Promote; RD passes chair to DG

Motion 8: The Promote Committee moves to approve funding not to exceed \$1,777.00 from line item **1.10 (Community Grants)** for the Wicker Park Bucktown Chamber of Commerce's 2019 End of Summer sale to take place on August 24th-25th throughout Wicker Park and Bucktown. (19-0611)

Motion 9: The Commission moves to approve funding not to exceed **\$70,000** from line item **1.06** (Holiday Decorations) for the first payment installment for the purchase of Hermans' Christmasland's snowflake decorations, to be displayed beginning with the 2019-2020 holiday season. (19-0704)
