<u>Motion 1:</u> The Commission recommends to approve funding not to exceed \$14,000 from line item 2.05 (Streetscape Elements) for Illuminight to provide and install string lights in Metzger Court (24-0603)

<u>Discussion:</u> The Commission discussed the style of lights that will be used (small LED white lights) and the installation process, which will involve wrapping the lights around the tree already placed in Metzger Court and stretching them to two poles that will be installed by Illuminight.

Motion 2: The Commission recommends that the Transportation Committee and Clean & Green Committee merge to create one committee.

<u>Motion 3:</u> The Clean & Green Committee recommends to approve funding not to exceed \$396,000 from line item 2.08 (Sidewalk Maintenance & Litter Abatement) for Cleanslate to provide snow removal and litter abatement services 7 days a week and After Dark services 2 days a week in 2025. (24-0601)

<u>Discussion:</u> The Commission clarified the change in contract from previous Cleanslate contracts (from 6 days to 7 days of litter abatement and SSA-wide snow removal). Commission requested that AH find out what kind of salt Cleanslate plans to use, as well as request that After Dark statistics be added to their monthly operations report.

<u>Motion 4:</u> The Clean & Green Committee recommends to approve funding not to exceed **\$18,000** from line item **2.07** (Sidewalk Litter Abatement – Supplies) for the purchase of fifteen (15) new trash cans and trash can liners to be placed within the boundaries of SSA #33. (24-0602)
