Updates

1. Snow Removal

- a. The Committee discussed the requirements for future snow removal services, including a 1" trigger with service up to 48" for the season. This will include sidewalk plow services, shoveling, and salting services, and will ideally be a joint effort between two firms come next winter, to make sure that we can receive 24-hour service for the neighborhood

2. Bike Fix-It Station

- a. Committee discussed the new fix-it station installation at Park 567, and recommended printing stickers that display directions on how to use the station directly on the equipment, along with a sticker that says "if this station is broken, please call SSA #33 at (773) 384-2672."

3. Rat Control

- a. The Committee discussed the expansion of the commercial rat birth control program, and decided on incremental expansion throughout the SSA boundaries, going block by block to make sure that each radius is being serviced properly.

4. Spring Plantings

- a. AH updated the committee that the spring plantings would likely be delayed due to a late-season freeze on April 6th.
